Page 6 RULES CORNER FROM YOUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

At some point you may have a sink or toilet blockage. If possible, please call the office before you engage a plumber. In the past, VPE has been charged \$350 for video inspections. VPE has purchased a drainage camera to inspect such problems and avoid such costs. Unless it is an emergency, you may be liable for those charges.

Trash Collection here at VPE.

All trash must be placed in tightly secured plastic bags or stored in tight fitting lid garbage cans, per park and county regulations. Please do not leave trash in garbage bags outside of the can. Animals will rip open the bags, which will attract rats to the area. Also, be aware that drops from citrus trees will also attract rats. We want to avoid these health risks. Thank you

RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION SERVICES WASTE MANAGEMENT

Curbside garbage and recycling collection services are provided to residents in unincorporated parts of Sarasota County by Waste Management.

- Garbage, yard waste and recyclable items are all collected on the same day.Containers/ items may be placed at the curb beginning at 5 p.m. the day before collection, and should be curbside by 6 a.m. on your collection day.Empty containers should be brought in from the curb by 10 a.m. on the day *following* collection.
- Yard waste should be placed separately from garbage and recyclables at the curb for collection. Bagged, containerized or bundled and tied, 4' or less in length, 40 pounds or less in weight.
- Other items that may be collected curbside are listed below. A complete list and preparation instructions can be viewed in the Residential How-To Guide.

Appliances (small kitchen), Electronics (stereos, computers, toaster, etc.), Bulk waste (furniture, mattresses, etc.), Construction wastes (limited to four, 32-gallon containers, each weighing 40 lbs. or less), Over-sized waste* (basketball

poles, exercise equipment, swing sets, etc.)TV's & Monitors** (under 40 lbs.),Used Motor Oil.

• Pickups for over-sized waste must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance with Waste Management. Call 941-493-4100. Service fees may apply.

Pickups for TV's and monitors that weigh more than 40 lbs. should be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance with Waste Management. Call 941-493-4100. **www.scgovt.net** for more information.*

Great Grandmom's Apple Crisp

- 3-4 apples, peeled, cored and cut into 1/2" cubes
- Preheat oven to 375F

- White sugar
- Nutmeg
- Cinnamon
- Flour
- Baking powder
- Salt
- 1 egg, slightly beaten

Lightly grease 8x8x2 baking dish or pan. In a bowl, peel and cut enough apples to fill this dish. Add 1/4 to 1/2* cup white sugar to the apples. Mix until coated. Sprinkle with a combination of nutmeg, cinnamon or combination of both. Mix and place all in the baking dish.

Topping: In a clean bowl, sift together 1 cup flour, 1/2 to1* cup white sugar, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1* teaspoon salt. Add 1 beaten egg and mix with dry ingredients until consistency of corn meal. Spread dry mixture over the apples. Melt 1/2 cup butter or margarine. Cool the butter slightly, then drizzle over the top of the mixture.

Bake uncovered at 375 F. for about 40 minutes. Tastes great warm with vanilla ice cream.

*Tips: I used gala and fuji apples. Any baking apple will do.

I like the lesser amounts of white sugar . Otherwise I find it overly sweet.

I like a combination of mostly nutmeg with a smaller amount of cinnamon.

I also use 1/2 teaspoon of salt instead of a full teaspoon.

Butter of course. Doesn't it make everything better?






