RECIPE OF THE MONTH

MISSISSIPPI POT ROAST

This super-simple recipe is a favorite of ours. The beef ends up fork tender with lots of tasty gravy, although the gravy is thin.

If you haven't yet tried a roast with peperoncini peppers you will be surprised at how delicious it is.

- Beef chuck roast, approximately 3#
- 2 T. vegetable oil
- ½ C. beef broth
- ¼ C. peperoncini juice
- 8 whole peperoncini peppers
- 2 T. ranch seasoning
- 1 T. onion powder
- ½ C. butter



In an oven-safe pot (think Dutch-oven), sear the chuck roast for 3-4 minutes on each side. Remove from heat and add the broth and peperoncini juice. Sprinkle over the beef the ranch dressing and onion powder. Top with the whole peperoncini peppers and whole stick of butter. Bake in a pre-heated oven for 3 hours, lid on, or until the meat can be shredded easily with a fork. This recipe could also be done in a slow-cooker. Just sear the beef on the stove, then cook on low for 8 hours. It is equally good served over mashed potatoes or rice or noodles.

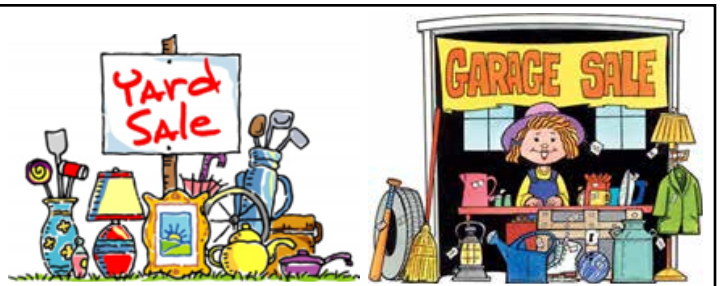
1/2/1956 HAPPY 67TH ANNIVERSARY for Yvonne and Reggie Eastman

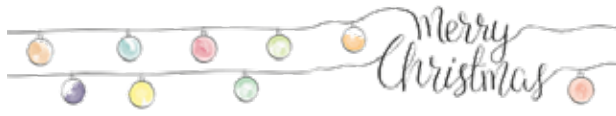
