GETTING TO KNOW YOU

Irv Rubin was born and raised as an only child into a Jewish home in The Bronx, living in a segregated community, similarly as those of other nationalities at that time. His father owned a produce store right at the top of the subway to Manhattan in which Irv helped out with deliveries, especially when his father was drafted in 1944 toward the end of the war. He graduated from a trade high school in Manhattan and then attended a Brooklyn community college trade school, having spent many hours traversing from one end of the subway to the other pursuing an education. Not adverse to travel, after earning a degree in mechanical technology at the 2-year trade school, he completed his engineering degree in 1960 from Montana University.

Irv worked for 34 years for ASCO (Automatic Switch Company) in quality control, match-mold dyes and procedures, and ultimately retired as a purchasing agent. Simultaneously, Irv served in the Army Reserve 6 years during the time of the Berlin Crisis and then owned a premier and thriving scuba/dive shop in New Jersey, having taught scuba to 4,000 people through the local YMCA. Wreck diving was very popular.

Irv has 2 adopted sons from his first marriage and 3 stepsons.

When Irv retired at age 55 he and his wife Gloria moved to Florida, and with Gloria's help, continued to arrange dive trips to the Caribbean, among others. They owned a boat for 10 years and also enjoyed a season living on Siesta Key followed by a community on Swift & Constitution, and finally, the Rubins moved to 2127 Ca'D'Or in 2012. For 23 years of his now-30 years of retirement, at each place they lived, Irv has served on the Board of his community as President with a vision of not living in the past but of looking toward the future. He is our current VPE president and also served the same from 2012-2014.

Sadly, Irv's wife Gloria passed away in the summer of 2021 and Irv was overwhelmed with the "doldrums." He found solace in his grief by once again volunteering on our VPE Board. He is a fixture every morning during the week at the clubhouse

where he indefatigably tackles his President work and coincidentally has found new purpose in the loss of his beloved Gloria. He also heads up the park's Texas Hold'em games on Monday and Friday, having had a long-time hobby of playing, both at casinos and online. He even recounted a time he won an online tourney with 7,000 players and was then able to compete in Las Vegas where he gave his opponents each a bag of shark's teeth, earning the title of "The Shark Man."

Irv says VPE is a friendly place and enjoys the diversity of all of the different regions represented in people that make up our park. He keeps in touch weekly with former neighbor Jeff Palumbo and spends every Wednesday afternoon at his stepson's home in Nokomis where they enjoy bagels and lox. Stop in to the clubhouse to say hello to Irv or shuffle in and join the Texas Hold'em gang. He is one of the many unique people that make up VPE, absorb his energy and emulate his example of living your senior years to the fullest.

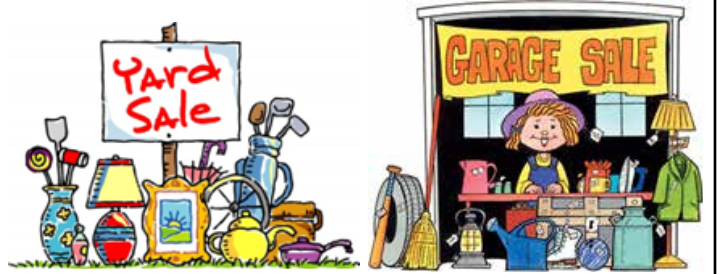

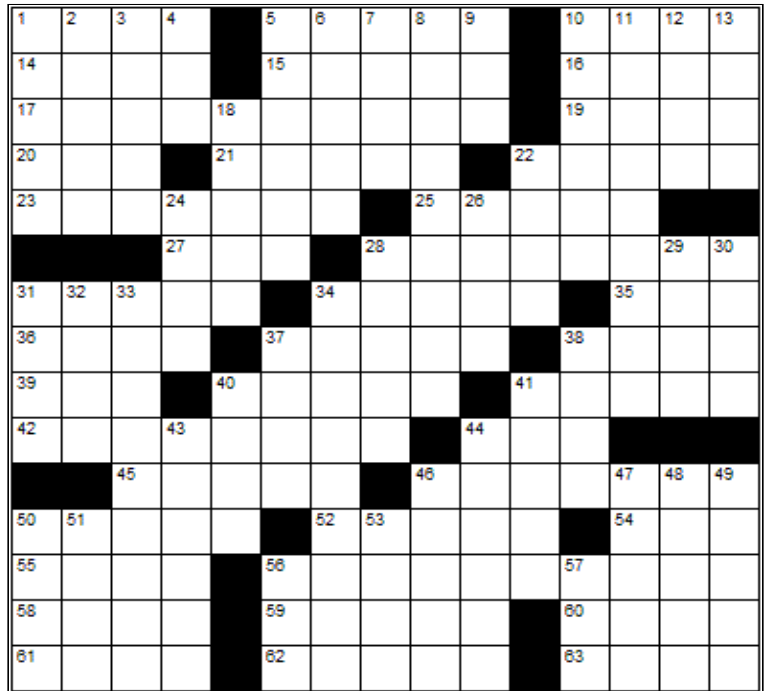
