



RECIPE OF THE MONTH

This month I have a special recipe for you! Sis Gavin has given us her recipe for her much-loved sugar cookies. I am not the only one who thinks they are melt-in-your-mouth delicious.

Those of you who haven't had

them are in for a treat.

Sis Gavin's Sugar Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 C. margarine (Imperial)
- 1 C. vegetable oil
- 1 C. powdered sugar
- 1 C. sugar
- 1 t. vanilla
- 2 eggs
- 4 C. flour
- 1 t. baking soda
- 1 t. salt
- 1 t. cream of tartar



Start by creaming together the margarine, oil and both sugars. Then mix in the vanilla and eggs. Next add in the flour, baking soda, salt and cream of tartar but do not sift them. After the dough has been chilled for a couple hours in the refrigerator or about 30 minutes in the freezer, roll the dough into one-inch balls. Sis uses a melon baller for this and then rolls the balls in sugar. Dip the bottom of a glass in sugar and press the dough balls flat. Bake at 375 degrees for 7 minutes. Cool on the cookie sheet for 2 minutes. Half of the recipe makes 4 dozen cookies.




