RECIPE OF THE MONTH

If you are looking for something a little different to serve when you are cooking hamburgers and hotdogs on the grill, try these cauliflower steaks. They are delicious, healthy and very easy to make. Your guests will be impressed!

Grilled Cauliflower Steaks

- 2 large heads cauliflower
- 3 cloves garlic, grated
- 2 large limes, zested and juiced
- 3 T. olive oil
- 1 t. honey
- ¾ T. chipotle powder
- 2 t. cumin
- Salt
- Pepper
- Fresh cilantro for garnish, optional



Level off the bottom of the cauliflower so you can stand it up straight and cut it vertically into 1" slices (steaks). Mix together lime zest, chipotle powder, cumin and salt and pepper. Combine lime juice, olive oil, honey and garlic in a separate bowl. Heat a grill to medium high. Brush steaks on one side with the olive oil mixture. Then sprinkle the chipotle seasoning mixture over the top of them. Put steaks seasoned side down on the grill. Next oil and season the other side of the steaks. Cover the grill and cook 5-7 minutes. Gently flip the steaks over and grill covered for another 5 minutes or until your desired tenderness. Garnish with cilantro if desired.

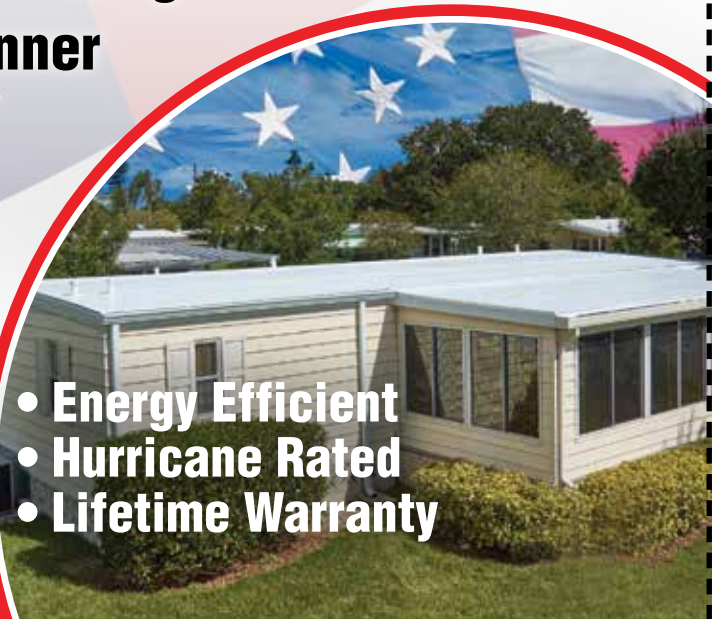
