

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Buttermilk blueberry breakfast bake is a fun thing to make ahead and have on hand for busy mornings during the holiday season (or, in fact, anytime!). It is a delicious treat to take

to friends or family when visiting them. You could make blueberry muffins but this recipe is easier and faster and a little more special.

Buttermilk Blueberry Breakfast Bake

- 2 C. flour, divided
- 2 C. fresh blueberries
- 1 C. sugar, plus extra for sprinkling on cake
- ¹/₂ C. buttermilk
- 1/2 C. unsalted butter, softened
- 1 lemon, zested
- 1 egg
- 2 t. baking powder
- 1 t. vanilla
- 1 t. salt

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a square 8 or 9-inch baking dish with butter or nonstick spray. In a medium bowl, whisk together 1 ³⁄₄ cups flour, baking powder and salt. In a large bowl, cream together butter and sugar and lemon zest for 3 – 5 minutes, or until fluffy and a lightened color. Add in egg and vanilla and beat until combined with butter mixture. Start with the buttermilk, take turns adding it with the flour mixture until everything is just combined. Toss the blueberries in remaining 1/4 cup flour until coated, then fold blueberries into batter. Pour batter into baking dish, then top with 1 - 2 tablespoons sugar. Bake for 40 minutes or until an inserted toothpick comes out clean.


