RECIPE OF THE MONTH

These green beans are a favorite of my grandkids. They will make a nice side dish with ham or lamb with your Easter dinner.

Bacon Braised Green Beans

Olive oil

(2) smashed garlic cloves (not chopped)
Pinch crushed red pepper flakes
1/2# button mushrooms, sliced
1/2# thick bacon, cut into small pieces
1# fresh green beans, cut into 1" pieces
1 C. chicken broth

Coat a large skillet with olive oil. Add bacon, garlic and red pepper flakes and cook over medium heat until the bacon is brown and crispy and no fat on it. Throw out the



garlic and all but a small amount of the bacon grease. Add the mushrooms, season with a little salt and cook 2-3 minutes. Add the beans and chicken stock. Cover and cook over medium heat for 40-45 minutes. (If the liquid reduces too much just add a little water.). Remove the lid and cook until almost all of the liquid is gone. When done the beans will be very tender.

The Venice area AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program provides in-person tax preparation help to anyone, free of charge, with a focus on taxpayers who are over 50 and have low to moderate income. Tax-Aide is the largest free, volunteer-based tax assistance and preparation program in the U.S.

Tax-Aide offers tax preparation services on an appointment basis in the Venice area. Taxpayers visit one of the sites and make an appointment where they receive instructions and preparation tools. At the tax preparation appointment, the taxpayer sits with a Tax Aide volunteer addressing questions while the return is prepared. Once completed a second volunteer will review the return for correctness and with the taxpayer. Upon agreement with the taxpayer, the return will then be filed.

Why it matters

The U.S. tax code is complicated. As a result, many taxpayers overpay, turn to services they can't afford, or don't file — missing out on credits and deductions they've earned.

What we do — and how we do it

During the 2022 tax season, more than 25,000 volunteers provided taxpayers in over 3,000 communities with free tax preparation and filing services. Tax-Aide volunteers are trained and IRS-certified every year to make sure they know about and understand the latest changes and additions to the tax code.

For the 2022 tax season, more than 25,000 volunteers served more than 1.2 million taxpayers, nearly 700,000 of whom were adults over 50 with low income. Tax-Aide participants saved more than \$1 billion in refunds and credits; older adults with low income saved almost \$375 million.




