

One of her brothers had a best friend growing

up named Stewart whom she would later marry. He was a civil engineer for the state and the couple lived their nearly 60 years of marriage in Woodstock, NY. They owned a 17-acre farm where Doris loved tractor mowing their three acres around their home. The



DeWitts had three sons (of which one lives nearby in Venice) as well as three grandchildren who bring her great joy. Their home was the house where all the kids would come and play and especially when the snow flew. She would join them playing, of course, and had an open-door policy. She was a Boy Scout den mother for years and knew the community well with her involvement on the fire department. The DeWitts property was the setting for Fourth of July fireworks and she recalls serving up an infinite number of hotdogs to any and all who would pop by.

Doris is a charter member of the Woodstock Fire Department. Volunteer at the time, Doris became an EMT and went out on calls as did Stewart and her sons. Their house was all abuzz with scanners with four of them in the family answering calls. She was part of the first all-women squad in Woodstock in 1974. Other jobs Doris held included working for an answering service, a doctor's office, and sold real estate.

The Dewitts had friends who owned a home on Ca'D'Oro which they rented for several seasons and then purchased their own home on Piazza in 2004. Doris enjoyed being on the VPE golf league and still shuffles on the shuffleboard league winning fourteen games this past season. In retirement, which she doesn't believe in, she regales with trips out West and Caribbean cruises with VPE friends.

Doris spends her off season back home, now in Olivebridge, NY, on her son's property where she built a small home. She helps with sorting dozens of eggs and other activities with her 10-year-old granddaughter at their farm. Doris credits her faith for strength and peace through the hard times, for her happy marriage, and her mother for her fierce (she will beat you at shuffleboard), fair and hardworking disposition.



#### RECIPE OF THE MONTH

It is that time of the year when peaches are at their best.

This is one of my favorite recipes and my family asks for it over and over. It is also very easy to make.

Just be sure to have some vanilla

ice cream on hand for it.

#### **Peach Cobbler**

Filling: 8 fresh peaches, peeled and sliced (9 cups)

½ C white sugar

½ t. cinnamon

1/4 t. ground nutmeg

1 T. fresh lemon juice

2 T. cornstarch

½ t. salt

#### Topping:

2 C. flour

1 C.white sugar

1 T. baking powder

½ t. salt

12 T. butter, chilled and cut into small pieces or grated

1/2 C. boiling water

#### **Biscuit Topping:**

2 t. cinnamon

1/3 C. sugar

In a large bowl, combine the filling ingredients. Stir to combine and transfer to a 9x13" baking dish. Bake for 10 minutes in a preheated 425 degree oven. In another mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, 1 cup sugar, baking powder and salt. Add the butter and combine. Stir in the boiling water quickly, just until combined. Batter will be lumpy. Drop topping over the hot peach filling in large spoonfuls. Stir together the remaining cinnamon and sugar and sprinkle over the top. Bake until top is golden brown and filling is bubbly, about 25-30 min.


