RECIPE OF THE MONTH

My husband and I first had this appetizer about 20 years ago on Anna Maria Island at Jackie's Cafe.

We enjoyed it so much I tried to duplicate it at home. It is also good with fig preserves instead of the onions. It makes a nice addition to your holiday get-togethers.

Baked Brie with Caramelized Onions

- 1 T. butter
- 1 large Vidalia onion (or other sweet onion)
- 1 T. brown sugar
- 1 small wheel (8 oz.) soft-ripened Brie cheese
- Bagel chips, grapes and pears

Melt butter in a nonstick pan. Cut the onion in half and then slice it. Add the onion, brown sugar, and one tablespoon of water. Cook until the onion is very soft and browned and the liquid has evaporated, about 35minutes. Meanwhile, preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Unwrap the Brie and place in an oven safe serving dish. Bake Brie for 10 minutes or until just warm to the touch. Top with the onion mixture. Serve with bagel chips and fruit.



FEMA ASSISTANCE

from Greg Ryan

Greg Ryan has this advice and suggestions to get financial assistance if you lost electricity and food due to Hurricane Milton:

CALL to have a person walk you through the FEMA Application. (You may have to be on hold for up to 30 minutes – so be ready).

Tell FEMA the following three (3) things:

- Let them know you need help filling out a FEMA Application and that you live in a mobile home in Sarasota and that by law you were required to evacuate and that "you were displaced" from your home prior to Hurricane Milton.
- 2. Tell them that you lost electricity (no lights, no water, no sewage) for at least 3 days: from Oct. 9th to Oct. 11 (or longer).
- 3. Tell them that you had to get or use "emergency water, food, etc." during this time. (Typically, people buy water and food before or during the hurricane as a direct result of the hurricane).

Note: if you give them your bank routing # and bank account – they will give you a direct deposit to your checking account for loss of electric and food – up to \$770. Several people in the Park have already received this assistance.


