RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Here is another easy and fast meal idea. Adults as well as children like it.

Chicken Tenders Parmesan

1 C. seasoned bread crumbs

1 T. Parmesan cheese, grated

1 egg, lightly beaten

12 chicken tenders, about 1 ½ lbs.

4 T. vegetable oil

1 C. bottled marinara sauce

12 fresh basil leaves

1 C. shredded four-cheese blend

Add the Parmesan cheese to the bread crumbs and put into a shallow dish. Put the egg into a shallow bowl. Dip the chicken in egg, shaking off the excess.



Now coat the chicken with bread crumbs and place on a plate. Heat 2 T. oil in a nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add half the chicken and cook for 3 minutes per side. Remove to a 13x9 inch baking dish. Repeat with the remaining 2 T. oil and remaining chicken. Spoon the marinara sauce over the chicken in the dish. Top each chicken tender with a basil leaf and sprinkle cheese over each one. Bake in a preheated 375 degree oven for 10 minutes or until the cheese melts. I serve it with ziti in marinara sauce and Parmesan cheese.

wonderful miracle. Welcome home Paul!





Everyone is welcome to come play Texas Hold'em on Monday and Friday at 12:45pm. The Monday/Friday version is "no limit". For newbies the







VENETIAN PARK ESTATES, Inc. - "STANDING" ADVISORY COMMITTEES

Presently, the Board of Directors at Venetian Park Estates, Inc. (VPE) is supported in their decision-making process by twelve (12) "Standing" Advisory Committees. An advisory committee is a collection of Cooperative Members who voluntarily contribute their knowledge/skills in areas which augment the knowledge and skills of the VPE BOD. Committee members offer insights and recommendations for action to the board when called upon. The advisory committee does not have formal authority to govern the organization, that is, the advisory committee cannot issue directives which must be followed. Rather, the advisory committee serves to make recommendations and/or provide key information and materials to the BODs. The advisory committee plays an important public relations role as well as fresh perspective on programmatic issues. A properly composed and structured advisory committee can be a tremendous complement to the effectiveness of the BODs as it works to carry out a specific initiative. The Chairperson of each is asked to provide a committee report at each of the regular Board meetings. Advisory committees need a sufficient range of expertise to accomplish the Board's mission.

Note: Of the 12 committees advising the Board, only three (3) have been given authority by the Board since 2014 to make decisions prior to a Board Meeting because of the nature of the work being considered. The Board then renders an "official" vote "retroactively" at the next regularly scheduled meeting to modify or confirm and approve the decisions made by these committees "for the record".

- 1. Architectural Review Committee (ARC): While the Board reserves the right to officially 'approve' an Owner's request to 'remove an existing home and install a new one', it gives authority to this committee to 'oversee' the "Application Process" for the removal and installation of new manufactured homes and structures on a Unit. This process often involves making decisions about the 'process' guiding both Builder and Unit Owner to comply with HUD, State, County and VPE Association's building codes. All actions taken by this committee are then presented to the Board at their next regular meeting.
- 2. Building & Grounds Committee: While the Board reserves the right to make all decisions regarding maintenance of VPE's buildings and grounds, it has given authority to this committee to make decisions between Board meetings in cases where emergencies arise involving broken water pipes, air conditioning, damage to our Treatment Plant, the Pool area or a Member's Home, which may put the well being of the Members or the Park at risk. All actions taken by this committee are then presented to the Board at their next regular meeting.
- 3. New Resident Committee: While the Board reserves the right to officially 'approve' any person or persons requesting an "Assignment of Lease" or a "Membership Certificate" prior to purchasing or residing in a home on VPE property, it extends this same authority to this committee between Board meetings. The Committee may approve a request for a Lease and Membership within the Cooperative between Board meetings ONLY when all criteria have been strictly met, including a successful interview and background check. This is done to allow for the legal Closings to take place. If Membership criteria is NOT MET in a satisfactory manner, the committee will immediately advise the Board to take action according to Article 10.6 of our Rules and Regulations.


