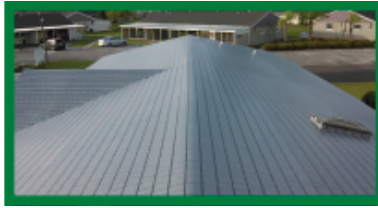

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

These Butter Swim Biscuits are so good! They are fluffy and light, but the butter makes them a little bit crispy on the outside. They also happen to be easier to make than drop biscuits because there is no rolling or cutting out. They would be a delicious addition to your Easter dinner.

2 ½ C. flour
2 C. buttermilk
1 stick butter, melted
4 t. baking powder
1 ½ T. sugar
2 t. salt

Whisk together the flour, baking powder, sugar and salt. Add the buttermilk and mix just until a moist dough is formed. Pour the melted butter into an 8x8 inch baking dish and then add the dough to the pan. As the dough is spread out to the corners of the pan, the butter surrounds it. Make cuts into the dough of equal squares so you can pull apart later. Bake at 450 degrees for 35 minutes.



ST. PATRICK'S DAY HORSE RACES

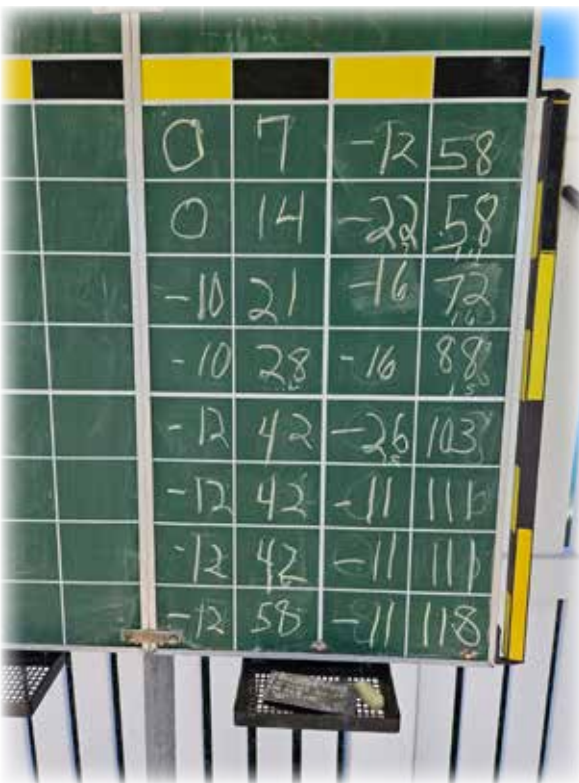


The annual horse race fund raiser went off without a hitch. We had a lot of volunteers and a lot of fun.

WATER RESTRICTIONS

Almost off of Florida — 98.8% of the state — is seeing conditions range from abnormally dry to extreme drought. Sarasota County is under a Modified Phase II & Severe & Water Shortage from Feb. 8, 2026, through July 1, 2026, restricting lawn watering to one day per week. Residents must follow specific schedules based on address, with allowed watering times restricted to before 8 a.m. or after 6 p.m. for properties under two acres.

Watering Schedule by Address (One Day Per Week)

- 0 or 1: Monday
- 2 or 3: Tuesday
- 4 or 5: Wednesday
- 6 or 7: Thursday
- 8 or 9: Friday

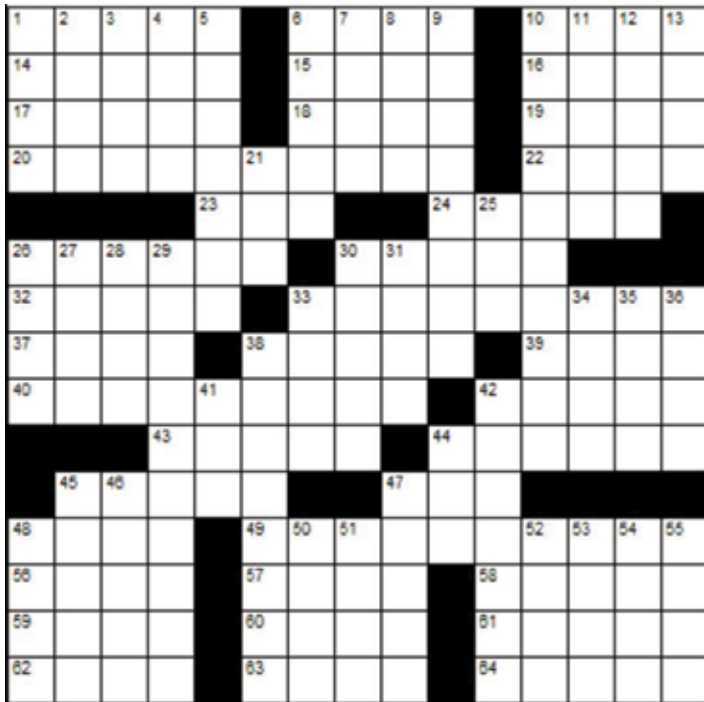
