VENETIAN PARK ESTATES, Inc. - "STANDING" ADVISORY COMMITTEES

Presently, the Board of Directors at Venetian Park Estates, Inc. (VPE) is supported in their decision-making process by twelve (12) "Standing" Advisory Committees. An advisory committee is a collection of Cooperative Members who voluntarily contribute their knowledge/skills in areas which augment the knowledge and skills of the VPE BOD. Committee members offer insights and recommendations for action to the board when called upon. The advisory committee does not have formal authority to govern the organization, that is, the advisory committee cannot issue directives which must be followed. Rather, the advisory committee serves to make recommendations and/or provide key information and materials to the BODs. The advisory committee plays an important public relations role as well as fresh perspective on programmatic issues. A properly composed and structured advisory committee can be a tremendous complement to the effectiveness of the BODs as it works to carry out a specific initiative. The Chairperson of each is asked to provide a committee report at each of the regular Board meetings. Advisory committees need a sufficient range of expertise to accomplish the Board's mission.

Note: Of the 12 committees advising the Board, only three (3) have been given authority by the Board since 2014 to make decisions prior to a Board Meeting because of the nature of the work being considered. The Board then renders an "official" vote "retroactively" at the next regularly scheduled meeting to modify or confirm and approve the decisions made by these committees "for the record".

1. Architectural Review Committee (ARC): While the Board reserves the right to officially 'approve' an Owner's request to 'remove an existing home and install a new one', it gives authority to this committee to 'oversee' the "Application Process" for the removal and installation of new manufactured homes and structures on a Unit. This process often involves making decisions about the 'process' guiding both Builder and Unit Owner to comply with HUD, State, County and VPE Association's building codes. All actions taken by this committee are then presented to the Board at their next regular meeting.

2. Building & Grounds Committee: While the Board reserves the right to make all decisions regarding maintenance of VPE's buildings and grounds, it has given authority to this committee to make decisions between Board meetings in cases where emergencies arise involving broken water pipes, air conditioning, damage to our Treatment Plant, the Pool area or a Member's Home, which may put the well being of the Members or the Park at risk. All actions taken by this committee are then presented to the Board at their next regular meeting.

3. New Resident Committee: While the Board reserves the right to officially 'approve' any person or persons requesting an "Assignment of Lease" or a "Membership Certificate" prior to purchasing or residing in a home on VPE property, it extends this same authority to this committee between Board meetings. The Committee may approve a request for a Lease and Membership within the Cooperative between Board meetings ONLY when all criteria have been strictly met, including a successful interview and background check. This is done to allow for the legal Closings to take place. If Membership criteria is NOT MET in a satisfactory manner, the committee will immediately advise the Board to take action according to Article 10.6 of our Rules and Regulations.

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ATTENTION: PROTECT YOUR FIBERNOW CONNECTION

TJ's Landscaping met with us in person for a tour of the orange Fibernow lines located behind the units. They will advise their staff not to use weed eaters anywhere near the wires. Please locate the orange Fibernow line that runs to your Fibernow Turtle and help protect this infrastructure. It is recommended that you place bricks or landscaping rocks around the line where necessary. A pile of rocks is available on the south side of the park entrance for residents to use as needed.

JULY RECIPE OF THE MONTH **DER DUTCHMAN BUTTERSCOTCH CLUSTERS**

In a large bowl:

4 cups corn flakes

AUGUST RECIPE OF THE MONTH **BISCUIT AND GRAVY EGG AND CHEESE** **CASSEROLE**

Bake at 350°

1 lb roll of breakfast sausage or turkey sausage roll

8 eggs

4 cups of milk OR I USE half and half (because it lasts forever) and use 2 cups plus 2 cups of water

1 small can country biscuits, (or make your own)

3 cups mild shredded cheese

Brown sausage, add ¼ cup flour (OR 4 Tablespoons)

Add half and half or the dairy of your choosing, 4 cups total and heat until thickened

In a greased pan or baking dish, add the eggs, quartered biscuits placed evenly into the eggs, and evenly sprinkle half the cheese.

Add all the gravy, evenly, and top with remaining cheese

Bake for 25 minutes, uncovered, then place foil on the top (not removing pan from oven), and bake for another 10 minutes. Spoon servings if eating right away.

I usually let it completely cool, place it in the refrigerator, then cut into squares and freeze individually in quart FREEZER BAGS. Then remove individually the night before and heat 1½ minutes and serve.

Broken glass is extremely difficult to see in water and on wet surfaces, and even a small piece can require the pool to be closed for cleanup. Please use plastic, metal, or other non-breakable containers while enjoying the pool area.

PUBLIC SERVICE **ANNOUNCEMENT**

Our waste water operator has informed us that we need to replace a pump that operates our sewage system. It can be expensive and it is preventable.

Our community's sewage system is designed to handle only human waste and toilet paper. When other materials are flushed—even items labeled “flushable”—they can build up in the lines and cause serious blockages. These blockages can lead to costly repairs for the entire community and may result in backups, service interruptions, or emergency maintenance. Please share this information with visiting guests or family.

Please put these items in the garbage and not the toilet:

Wipes of any kind (including “flushable” wipes)

Paper towels or tissues

Feminine hygiene products

Cotton swabs, dental floss, or bandages

Grease, oils, or food scrap

Cat litter or pet waste bags

Any other non-toilet-paper materials

Only flush:

Human waste and toilet paper.

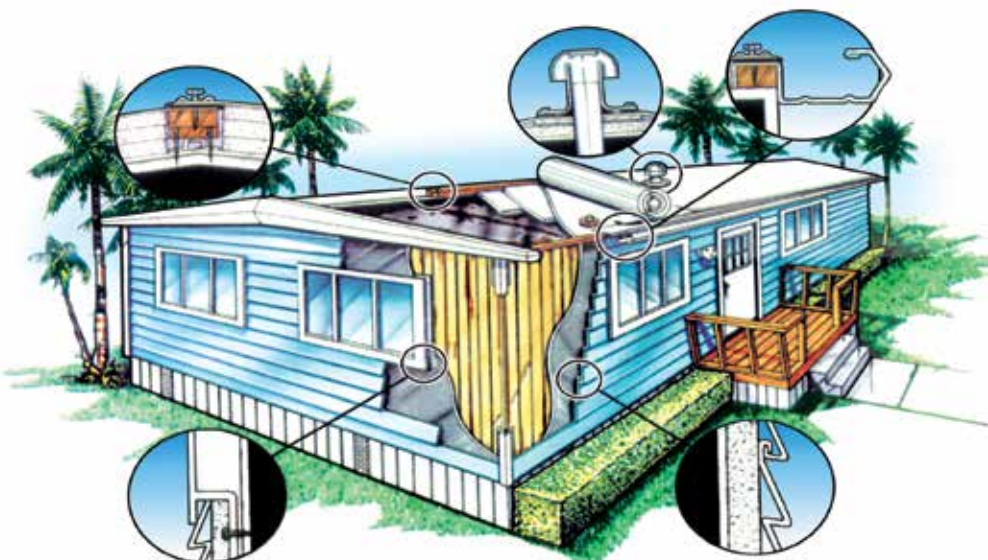

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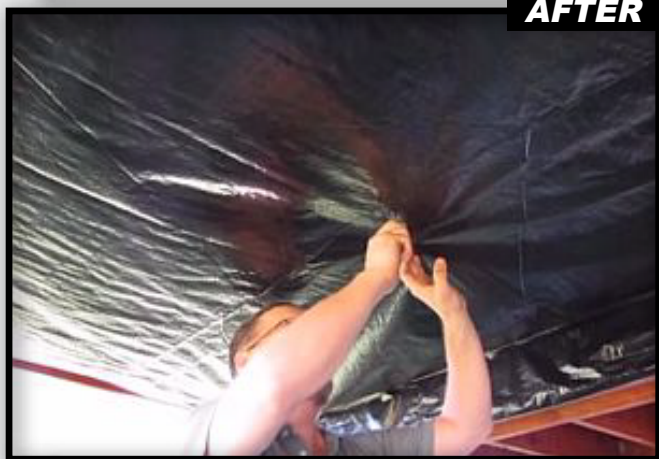
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COFFEE HOUR

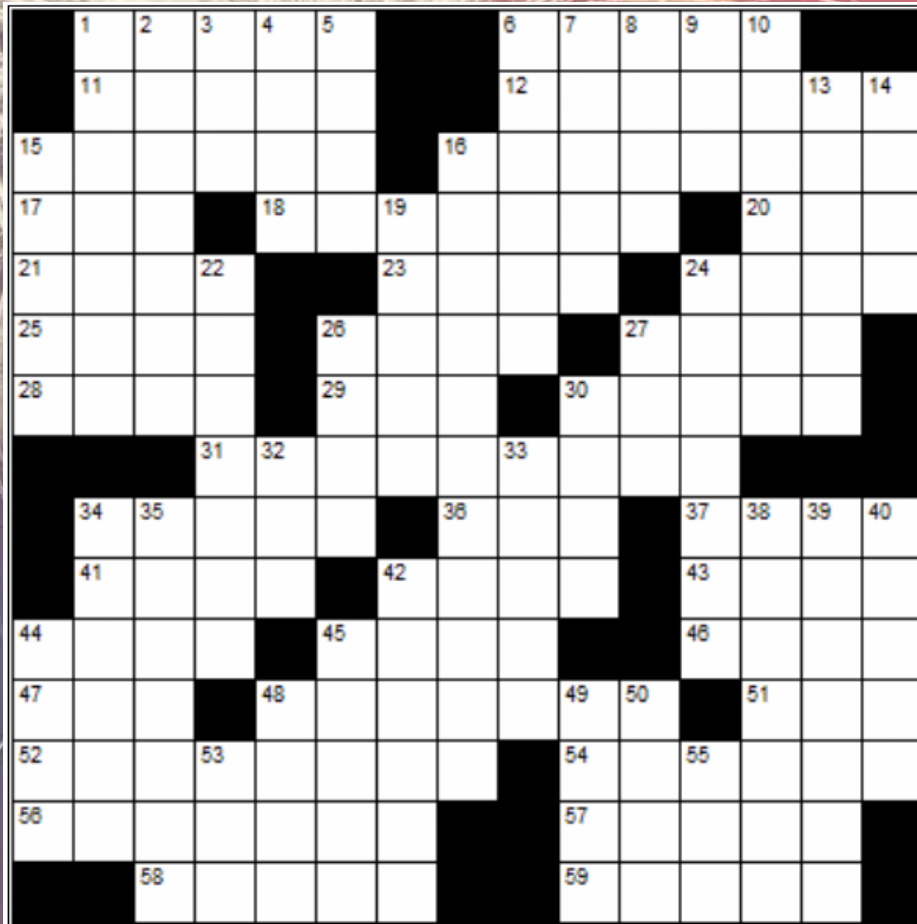


THE 4TH OF JULY
