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VENETIAN PARK ESTATES, Inc. - "STANDING" ADVISORY COMMITTEES

Presently, the Board of Directors at Venetian Park Estates, Inc. (VPE) is supported in their decision-making process by twelve (12) "Standing" Advisory Committees. An advisory committee is a collection of Cooperative Members who voluntarily contribute their knowledge/skills in areas which augment the knowledge and skills of the VPE BOD. Committee members offer insights and recommendations for action to the board when called upon. The advisory committee does not have formal authority to govern the organization, that is, the advisory committee cannot issue directives which must be followed. Rather, the advisory committee serves to make recommendations and/or provide key information and materials to the BODs. The advisory committee plays an important public relations role as well as fresh perspective on programmatic issues. A properly composed and structured advisory committee can be a tremendous complement to the effectiveness of the BODs as it works to carry out a specific initiative. The Chairperson of each is asked to provide a committee report at each of the regular Board meetings. Advisory committees need a sufficient range of expertise to accomplish the Board's mission.

Note: Of the 12 committees advising the Board, only three (3) have been given authority by the Board since 2014 to make decisions prior to a Board Meeting because of the nature of the work being considered. The Board then renders an "official" vote "retroactively" at the next regularly scheduled meeting to modify or confirm and approve the decisions made by these committees "for the record".

1. Architectural Review Committee (ARC): While the Board reserves the right to officially 'approve' an Owner's request to 'remove an existing home and install a new one', it gives authority to this committee to 'oversee' the "Application Process" for the removal and installation of new manufactured homes and structures on a Unit. This process often involves making decisions about the 'process' guiding both Builder and Unit Owner to comply with HUD, State, County and VPE Association's building codes. All actions taken by this committee are then presented to the Board at their next regular meeting.

2. Building & Grounds Committee: While the Board reserves the right to make all decisions regarding maintenance of VPE's buildings and grounds, it has given authority to this committee to make decisions between Board meetings in cases where emergencies arise involving broken water pipes, air conditioning, damage to our Treatment Plant, the Pool area or a Member's Home, which may put the well being of the Members or the Park at risk. All actions taken by this committee are then presented to the Board at their next regular meeting.

3. New Resident Committee: While the Board reserves the right to officially 'approve' any person or persons requesting an "Assignment of Lease" or a "Membership Certificate" prior to purchasing or residing in a home on VPE property, it extends this same authority to this committee between Board meetings. The Committee may approve a request for a Lease and Membership within the Cooperative between Board meetings ONLY when all criteria have been strictly met, including a successful interview and background check. This is done to allow for the legal Closings to take place. If Membership criteria is NOT MET in a satisfactory manner, the committee will immediately advise the Board to take action according to Article 10.6 of our Rules and Regulations.

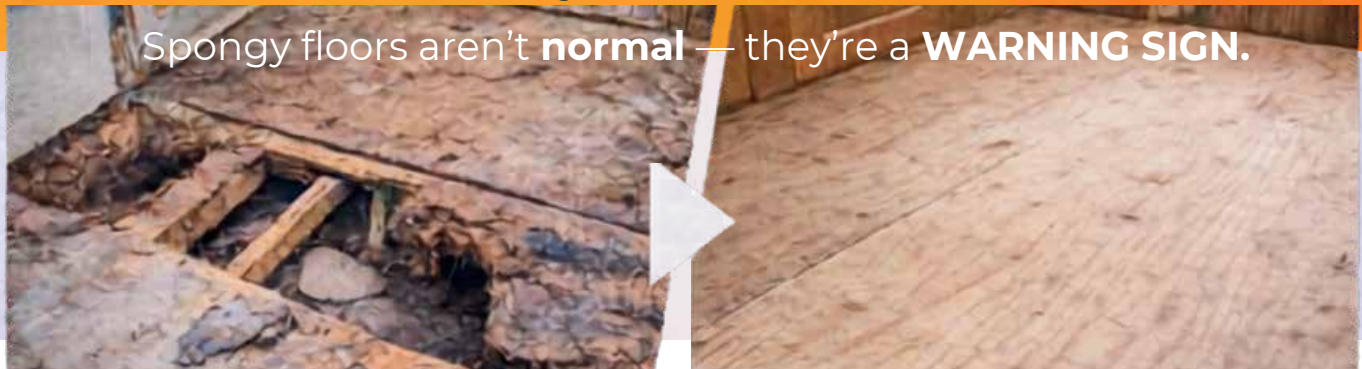

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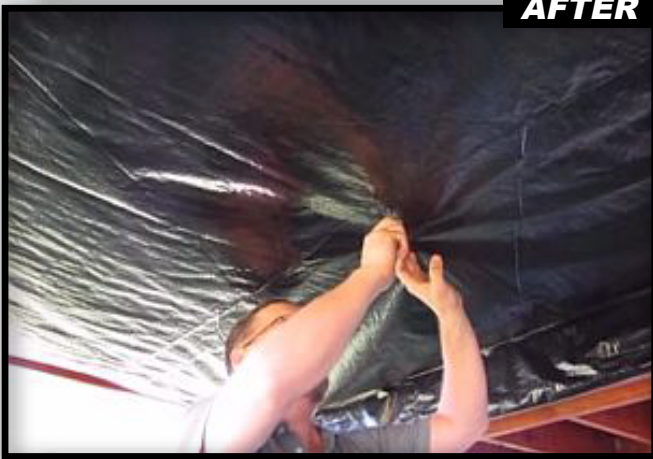

Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida

Position Statement on Proposed
Constitutional Amendment No. 3



Property Tax Relief Amendment

The Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida (FMO) Board of Directors has voted to **oppose Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. on the general election ballot in November.**

Our decision is based on:

Manufactured homeowners living in land-lease communities will receive little or no direct benefit from this amendment, while many will likely experience indirect/negative financial consequences. This amendment would create an imbalance and unequal position for residents of land-lease manufactured home communities.

What the Amendment Does:

If approved by sixty percent of Florida voters who vote, the amendment would:

- Expand the homestead exemption for qualifying homeowners who own both their home and the land on which it sits.
- Limit annual increases in the assessed value of many commercial properties to 5%.

What the Amendment Does Not Do:

For residents of land-lease manufactured home communities, the amendment does **not** provide a larger homestead exemption because they do not own the land beneath their homes.

Simply put, land-lease manufactured homeowners would not receive the primary tax benefit promoted by the amendment.

Why This Matters:

Property taxes help fund essential local government services, including public safety, emergency services, public health programs, roads, parks, libraries, and other community services. If property tax revenue grows more slowly because of expanded exemptions and limits on commercial property assessments, local governments will consider other ways to balance their budgets.

Possible responses could include:

- Increased monthly utility fees or service charges.
- New or higher monthly or special assessments.
- Reduced local government services.
- Delays in infrastructure improvements.

Each city and county would make its own

decisions, so the impact could vary throughout Florida.

A Unique Situation for Manufactured Homeowners

Manufactured homeowners in land-lease communities occupy a unique position.

- These homeowners will **not** receive the expanded homestead exemption.
- Community owners may benefit from slower growth in commercial property taxes
- Residents could still face higher local fees, assessments, or reduced public services if local government revenues decline.

While the FMO cannot predict exactly how local governments will respond, the strong potential exists for manufactured homeowners to bear additional monthly fees and costs without receiving the amendment's primary benefit.



Why the FMO Opposes the Amendment:

The FMO supports tax policies that are fair and equitable for manufactured homeowners.

After reviewing this proposal, the Board concluded that the **amendment creates an imbalance for residents of land-lease manufactured home communities.** Our members would receive no direct tax relief while remaining vulnerable to possible increases in local monthly fees, assessments, or reductions in public services.

For these reasons, the Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida respectfully opposes Proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 3.

Be an Informed Voter:

The FMO encourages every manufactured homeowner to read the proposed amendment, understand how it may affect you and your community, and make an informed decision when casting your ballot. To assist your decision, please learn how your city and county intend to replace the lost local revenue.

Our mission is to advocate for policies that protect the interests of Florida's manufactured homeowners. The FMO will continue to do so while we fulfill our mission to protect your rights.

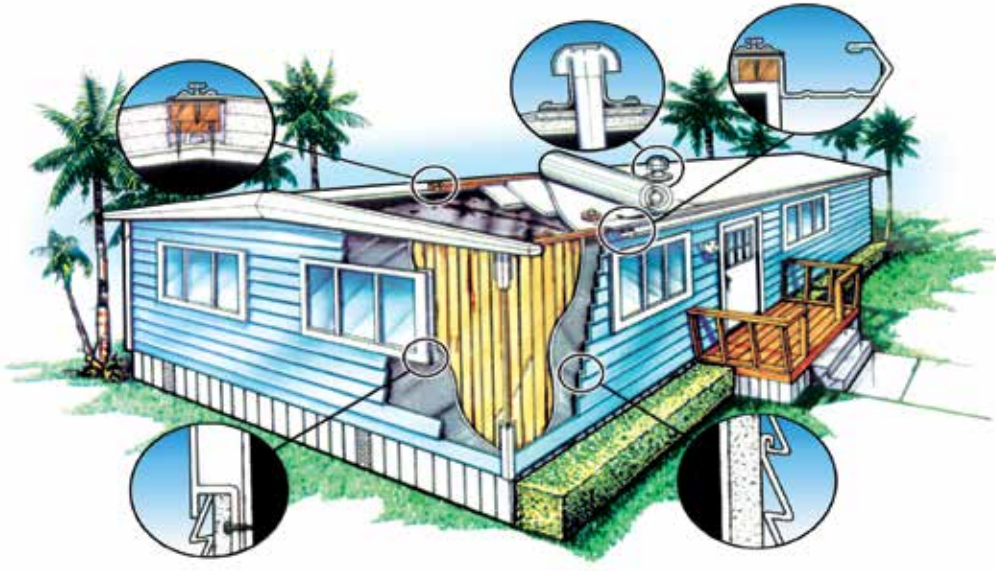

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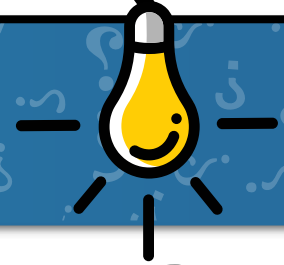

Charity and Disaster Fraud

Charity fraud schemes seek donations for organizations that do little or no work—instead, the money goes to the fake charity's creator.

While these scams can happen at any time, they are **especially prevalent after high-profile disasters**. Criminals often use tragedies to exploit you and others who want to help.

After a natural disaster or other emergency, unethical contractors and other scammers may commit insurance fraud, re-victimizing people whose homes or businesses have been damaged. Sometimes these fraudsters even pretend to be affiliated with the government, when they are not. If you need any post-disaster repairs, do your research before hiring any contractor.

Protect Yourself. The following tips can help you avoid these schemes:

- **Give to established charities** or groups whose work you know and trust.
- Be aware of organizations with **copycat names** or names similar to reputable organizations.
- Be wary of new organizations that **claim to aid victims of recent high-profile disasters**.
- Do your research. Use the Federal Trade Commission's resources to examine the track record of a charity.
- **Give using a check or credit card.** If a charity or organization asks you to donate through cash, gift card, virtual currency, or wire transfer, it's probably a scam. Learn more about this trick from the FTC.
- **Practice good cyber hygiene:**
 - Don't click links or open email attachments from someone you don't know.
 - Manually type out links instead of clicking on them.
 - Don't provide any personal information in response to an email, robocall, or robotext.
 - Check the website's address—**most legitimate charity organization websites use .org, not .com.**
- After a natural disaster or other emergency, carefully **vet any contractors before hiring them to work on your home or business.**
